Masters of Science in Information Technology and Management (MSc IT & Management)

MSc Information Technology and Management (MSc IT & Management) degree is a collaborative programme run jointly by the Avinashilingam University of India and the Institute of Finance Management (IFM), Tanzania.

Programme Objective

The programme aims at providing students with sound knowledge and combined skills of Management, Software and Networking Technologies. The programme is tailor-made on request of various information technology (IT) organisations.

Carrier Opportunities

The programme develops professionals suited for the top positions in the IT management field. The degree meets the needs of the modern management-level technology professional responsible for the planning, budgeting, design, integration and deployment of strategic enterprise technologies and programs that contribute to the business organization's success.

Programme Duration

The programme run during the evening and it is for two (2) years.

Entry Requirement and Eligibility

Bachelor degree or Advanced Diploma (at least 3 years duration) in any formal science related field of study with at least second class, OR a good postgraduate diploma in the related field from an accredited higher learning institution. Applications are invited from Tanzanian and Foreign applicants.

Application Fee

Applicants have to pay a non-refundable application fee of TZS 10,000/= . For other fees (registration, allowance, field attachment, caution money etc); please contact the admissions office or visit the IFM website.

Tuition Fee Structure

- i) For Tanzanians is US \$ 5,000 payable in four installments; US \$ 1250 per installment.
- ii) For Foreign Students is US \$ 6,600 payable in four Installments; @ US \$ 1,650 per installment.

2. Application starts in June of each academic year. The deadline for submitting the applications for this program is 30th September of each academic year. Class sessions are expected to start in November of each academic year.
